## **Go Deep Operational Gifts Of The Holy Spirit**

Reminder: these gifts are for both evangelism and edification. We have to have both in a healthy church.

Both 1 and 2 Corinthians are Paul's corrective words to the Christians at Corinth. They were arguing about which super-apostle to follow, bragging about their resumes of spiritual gifts, and often ignoring the glaring sins that needed to be addressed. This is true for Paul's teaching on these nine operational gifts—1 Corinthians 12:1-2.

1.	Unlike the motivational gifts (Romans 12:4-6) which are given permanently to people, the operational gifts are given according to the Holy Spirit's w and t (1 Corinthians 12:11).

3.	Neither frequency or infrequency of the manifestation of gifts, nor the number of gifts manifested through an individual determine $\underline{s}$ $\underline{m}$ . The true measure is the fruit of the Spirit (1 Corinthians 13:1-3; Galatians 5:22-23).		
4.	The operational gifts can be <u>i</u> or <u>c</u> by satan (Matthew 7:21-23; 24:11, 24; 2 Corinthians 11:13-15; 2 Thessalonians 2:8-10).
